# CITIZENS FORUM

- USIBWC established the Rio Grande Citizens Forum Board in 1999 at El Paso, TX-Las Cruces, NM
- Program expanded in early 2000s
  - USIBWC CF in San Diego County
  - Colorado River CF in Yuma and Imperial Counties
  - Southeast Arizona CF
  - Lower Rio Grande CF (TX) - 2003
- Mexican Section established Citizens Forum in 2014.
