**USIBWC DOVE HUNTING POLICY
LIST OF AFFECTED AREAS**

Hunters will see large blue signs with bright yellow numbers on the border fence and across the Rio Grande in Mexico. The list below corresponds to the numbers on those signs. Hunters should pay close attention to the numbers on the signs to determine whether dove hunting is permitted in any given area. Hunting is prohibited along USIBWC lands in the City of El Paso and near residential or commercial buildings.

No Hunting: Ysleta-Zaragoza International Bridge to #52

Hunting Permitted: #52 to #53

No Hunting: #53 to # 59

Hunting Permitted: #59 to #67

No Hunting: #67 to #73

Hunting Permitted: #73 to # 84

No Hunting: #84 to #86

Hunting Permitted: #86 to #89

No Hunting: #89 to #95

Hunting Permitted: downstream from #95 in Hudspeth County
