AMISTAD DAM ROAD TO CLOSE JANUARY 28-FEBRUARY 4

The Mexican Section of the International Boundary and Water Commission has informed the U.S. Section that the road across Amistad Dam will close from Thursday, January 28 through Thursday, February 4, 2016. The closure will affect the Amistad Dam Road at the United States Port of Entry.

Mexican officials will be performing maintenance on the dam's gates in Mexico, with heavy equipment blocking the road, as well as cleaning and painting along the roadway. The road will reopen February 5.

During the closure, motorists traveling to or from Mexico are advised to use the Del Rio, Texas-Ciudad Acuña, Coahuila International Bridge.

The International Boundary and Water Commission, United States and Mexico, is responsible for applying the boundary and water treaties between the two countries. In accordance with the treaties and other international agreements, the Commission operates and maintains Amistad Dam.
