U.S.-MEXICO RELEASE BINATIONAL STUDY OF THE SAN PEDRO RIVER AQUIFER

The United States Section of the International Boundary and Water Commission (USIBWC), and Mexico announce the release of the report: *Binational Study of the Transboundary San Pedro Aquifer*. The binational report is a collaborative effort between the IBWC and a binational team of scientists from the United States and Mexico working closely together to produce maps, data, and other scientific information coordinated across the Arizona – Sonora international border.

The agencies involved on the project include the U.S. Geological Survey, the University of Arizona Water Resources Research Center, National Water Commission (Mexico), and the University of Sonora.

“This binational effort and the compilation of data and maps in this report will serve to foster comity and provide useful information needed to understand our shared water resources in the region,” said USIBWC Principal Engineer Jose A. Nuñez.

The binational team is continuing their efforts and will produce a similar report for the Santa Cruz aquifer, another transboundary aquifer, and should be completed in 2017.


