ADDITIONAL MONUMENTS ON THE LAND BOUNDARY BETWEEN INTERPATIONAL MONUMENTS NUMBERS 2 AND 3

The Commission met in the offices of the Mexican Section at Ciudad Juárez, Chihuahua at 10:00 a.m. on June 23, 1967, to consider the "Joint Report of the Principal Engineers on the Placement of Additional Monuments Between International Monuments Numbers 2 and 3", submitted by Principal Engineers William E. Walker and Norberto Sánchez G. on June 13, 1967, the English and Spanish texts of which are attached to the present Minute and form a part thereof.

The Commission reviewed the Joint Report under reference and found it to be in conformity with the provisions of Article I of the Boundary Treaty concluded between the United States and Mexico on December 30, 1853.

Accordingly, the Commission adopted the following resolution, subject to the approval of the two Governments:

- 1. The Joint Report of the Principal Engineers attached hereto and forming a part of this Minute is approved.
- 2. Approval is given to the location and placement of the additional monuments 2A, 2B and 2C referred to in the Joint Report under reference so as clearly to mark the land boundary between monuments 2 and 3.
- 3. The additional monuments cited in resolution 2 of this Minute form a part of the monumentation of the land boundary between the United States and Mexico.

The meeting then adjourned.
