MINUTE NO. 257

El Paso, Texas May 18, 1977

COMPLETION OF THE RELOCATIONS OF THE RIO GRANDE STIPULATED IN ARTICLE I OF THE TREATY OF NOVEMBER 23, 1970

The Commission met in the offices of the United States Section in El Paso, Texas at 2:00 P.M., on May 18, 1977, to confirm in a Minute that the changes in location of the channel of the Rio Grande stipulated in paragraphs A, B and C of Article I of the Treaty of November 23, 1970, have been completed.

The Commission agreed that the three changes in the location of the channel of the Rio Grande, stipulated in paragraphs A, B and C of Article I of the Treaty of 1970 have been completed, and that the relocations were effected so that the middle of the new channels of the river followed the alignments shown on the maps cited in the same paragraphs of that Treaty.

The Commission agreed that the change in the location of the channel of the Rio Grande in the area of the Presidio-Ojinaga tracts was performed so as to transfer from the north to the south of the middle of the relocated channel an area of 1,606.19 acres (650.00 hectares), as stipulated in Article I A of the Treaty of 1970; that the change in the location of the channel of the Rio Grande upstream from and near Hidalgo-Reynosa was performed so as to transfer from the south to the north of the middle of the relocated channel an area of 481.68 acres (194.93 hectares), as stipulated in Article I B of that Treaty; and that the change in the location of the channel of the Rio Grande downstream from and near Presidio-Olinaga was performed so as to transfer from the south to the north of the middle of the relocated channel, an area of 252.00 acres (101.98 hectares), as stipulated in Article I C of the same Treaty.
