## **Mexican IBWC Resumes Operations at PBCILA Pumping Station**

Yesterday, the Mexican Section of the International Boundary and Water Commission (CILA) resumed operations at the PBCILA pumping plant with the goal of reducing cross-border flows through the Tijuana River.

PBCILA pump operations were suspended on November 15, 2025, to protect equipment after heavy rain fall in the area. Sediment removal work has been ongoing since March of this year.

Now that the system is back online, SBIWTP can resume receiving up to 35 million gallons a day from the Tijuana sanitation system.
